Buggin' Out: Week 2, June 18th-22nd

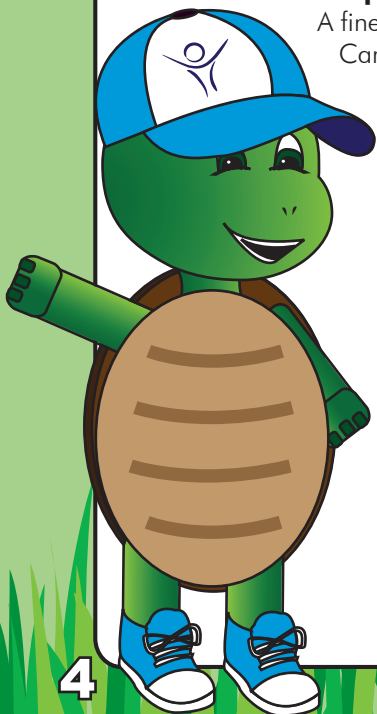
From insects and spiders to crayfish and millipedes, discover what makes these creatures unique. We will search for insects, study how they live and maybe even touch some live bugs!

Treasure Island: Week 3, June 25th-June 29th

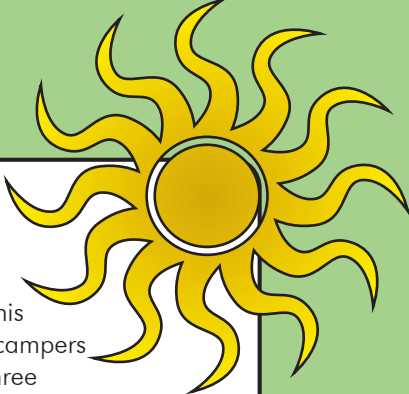
